Acts 13:1-3

- 13 Now in the church at Antioch there were prophets and teachers: Barnabas, Simeon who was called Niger, Lucius of Cyrene, Manaen a member of the court of Herod the ruler, and Saul. 2 While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, "Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them." 3 Then after fasting and praying they laid their hands on them and sent them off. (New Revised Standard Version)

- Q3. What did they do, and what did the Spirit of God say? v.2
- Q4. How did they send the missionaries? v.3

- D2. What is the most important lesson that you learned from the passage?
- D3. Where are Antioch and Jerusalem? Mark those two cities on the map.
